- Must be at least 21 years of age for Police Officer positions and 18 years of age for Communications Technician and other non-police positions.
- Must hold a high school diploma or GED.
- Must be a United States Citizen.
- Can not have any prior convictions for:
 - any felony
 - any crime involving moral turpitude, perjury, or making false statements.
- Must have an acceptable driving record.
- Must maintain a lifestyle free of illegal drug use.
- Must be neat in appearance, well groomed with good personal hygiene.
- Must possess an Honorable Discharge from the Armed Forces, if applicable.
- Must have no visible branding, tattoos, or body art while in summer uniform.
