Man faces multiple theft charges

SUMTER, SC (Oct. 13, 2017) – A Sumter man remains in jail on a \$75,000 bond after being charged with multiple car and structure break-ins in the city.

William Lemoin Armstrong II, 33, of 287 Tiger Lily Road, is being held at the Sumter-Lee Regional Detention Center.

He is charged with petit larceny (enhancement), six counts of breaking and entering an automobile, four counts of burglary-2nd degree and one count burglary-3rd degree.

Armstrong is involved in a number of vehicle and storage shed/area break-ins that happened between Oct. 3 and Oct. 4 at homes along Henrietta Street and Crestwood Drive.

Items reported stolen included electronic devices, tools and fishing, hunting and camping equipment

Armstrong was arrested following a traffic stop on Oct. 6. Items found inside the vehicle he was driving tied him to the reported break-ins.

Armstrong was out on probation at the time of his arrest. An investigation is continuing.
