2 face charges in pawn shop break-in

SUMTER, SC (March 23, 2017) – A man and woman captured on surveillance video while breaking into a local pawn shop have been identified and face charges.

Warrants were issued this week for Brandon William Jones, 23, of 3330 W. Cummings Road, Effingham, and Gayla Elizabeth Feagin, 26, of 730 Rio Drive, Darlington.

Information developed in the case connected them to the Jan. 20 break-in of Top Dollar Pawn Shop, McCray's Mill Road, where a laptop computer and a long gun were reported stolen.

On Monday, Sumter Police charged Jones, with burglary-1st degree, criminal conspiracy and possession of tools used in a crime. Jones, who has been in custody since February on unrelated charges, is being held at the Sumter-Lee Regional Detention Center.

Feagin is being held in the Florence County Detention Center, where she faces unrelated charges in Florence County. The warrants issued for burglary-2nd degree, criminal conspiracy and possession of tools used in a crime in connection to the Top Dollar break-in will be served once custody of Feagin is transferred to the Sumter Police Department.
