



Prom Promise/In an Instant

Each year before the prom, juniors and seniors at Sumter High School are given a realistic dose of what could happen during a drunken or distracted driving accident.

Sumter Police coordinate with area first responder agencies and the Sumter School District to present these programs in an effort to discourage teens from making potentially deadly decisions on prom night or at any other time in their lives.

Prom Promise -- which simulates a fatal drunken driving scenario from the prom to the court system -- and **In an Instant**, where students can wear goggles to simulate being impaired, are presented on alternate years.
